

RESOLUTION 2008-1784
Adopted September 19, 2007

WHEREAS, The Commissioners of the Washington Suburban Commission, in compliance with directives in Md. Ann. Code Art. 29, § 3-110(c)(1)(i), must establish the qualifications for defining a Small Business as it is referenced in COMAR 21.11.01.04. For purposes of awarding contracts under the WSSC Small, Local, Minority Business Enterprise Program; and

WHEREAS, "'Small business' means a business, other than a broker which meets the following criteria:


- (a) It is independently owned and operated;
- (b) It is not a subsidiary of another firm;
- (c) It is not dominant in its field of operation;
- (d) Its wholesale operations did not employ more than 50 persons, and its gross sales did not exceed an average of \$ 2,000,000 in its most recently completed 3 fiscal years;
- (e) Its retail operations did not employ more than 25 persons and its gross sales did not exceed an average of \$ 2,000,000 in its most recently completed 3 fiscal years;
- (f) Its manufacturing operations did not employ more than 100 persons, and its gross sales did not exceed an average of \$ 2,000,000 in its most recently completed 3 fiscal years;
- (g) Its service operations did not employ more than 100 persons, and its gross sales did not exceed an average of \$ 2,000,000 in its most recently completed 3 fiscal years; and
- (h) Its construction operations did not employ more than 50 persons, and its gross sales did not exceed an average of \$ 7,000,000 in its most recently completed 3 fiscal years."

COMAR 21.11.01.04.; and

BE IT RESOLVED THAT as mandated by Maryland Law Md. Ann. Code art. 29, § 3-110(c)(1)(i), the WSSC Commissioners hereby adopt Resolution 2008-1784; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this Resolution is effective after publication in accordance with Art. 29, § 9-101(b) and upon compliance with all other requirements for new regulations adopted by the WSSC.
