Comprehensive Renovation Plan

General Services and Production are working to develop a comprehensive renovation plan to:

- Replace outdated HVAC & electrical systems
- Improve efficiency & save money
- Comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

- Retain staff & attract new workers
- Incorporate new workplace trends





Original Scope

- Evaluate 3 buildings at Anacostia as part of pilot program
 - Evaluate deficiencies, staffing needs, prioritize upgrades
 - Select 1 building for renovations as part of pilot program

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- Design of new Lyttonsville Depot
- Fully renovate RGH building

Revised Scope

- Cancel full renovation of RGH due to project cost
- Initiate condition assessments for RGH and Anacostia pilot buildings to identify, prioritize and bundle needs
- Move forward with smaller upgrades to several floors in RGH
 - Upgrade electrical, IT cables, old carpet/furniture
 - Maximize space and enhance safety/security on lobby level
 - Ensure ADA compliance
 - Maximize use of empty space on 10th floor
 - Relocate Inspector General Office to offsite leased space


Full renovation costs will be developed following completion of comprehensive condition assessments





RGH Lobby Renovation goals

- Enhance safety and security while fostering a welcoming experience
 - Install self-service kiosks
 - Add turnstiles and glass door to secure elevator lobby
 - Move Police and Homeland Security to lobby level
- Install new ADA compliant front entry glass doors
- Increase space for Credit Union





Estimated Costs for Short-Term RGH Upgrades

Project Phase	Schedule	Estimated Cost
<u>10th floor</u> - Targeted renovation (Electrical, IT cabling, flooring, walls and furniture)	2019 - 2020	\$2M
Lobby - Security upgrades, Credit Union Expansion (Electrical, IT cabling, flooring, walls and furniture)	2020 - 2021	\$1.9M
<u>2nd floor</u> - System Control Room & Radio Room upgrades (Electrical, flooring, walls, furniture and console)	2020 - 2021	\$600K
<u>8th floor</u> - minor demolition, reconfiguration of space	2020-2021	\$50K
TOTAL		\$4.55M

Full renovations costs will be developed following completion of comprehensive condition assessment

- RGH short-term renovation
 - Develop IDIQ for general contractor
 - Finalize revised plans for 10th floor and lobby
 - Upgrade System Control Room and Radio Room
