WASHINGTON SUBURBAN SANITARY COMMISSION ADOPTS CROSS CONNECTION CONTROL PROGRAM REGULATION

On June 18, 2014, the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (“WSSC”) voted to adopt a Regulation entitled “Cross Connection Control Program” (SP No. REG-REGS-EC-2014-004) to supersede and replace SP No. ENG 09-05.

The Regulation provides the framework for WSSC’s implementation of its Cross Connection Control Program (“CCC Program”), which is applied in accordance with the latest provisions of the WSSC Plumbing and Fuel Gas Code (“Code”). The Regulation and the Code contain requirements affecting all water customers and the licensed plumbing industry. The Regulation’s primary purpose is to change the fee structure for the CCC Program. A new fee will be imposed on all WSSC commercial water customers’ water bills. Most commercial customers will be charged \$6 per month, although customers with higher risk water uses will be charged \$12 per month. The CCC Program’s Test Report Submittal Fee will increase from \$10 to \$25.
