WSSC Adopts Fraud, Waste, and Abuse Hotline Policy

On April 21, 2010, the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC) adopted a Fraud, Waste and Abuse Hotline Policy. This Policy establishes procedures for WSSC employees and other customers/stakeholders of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District (WSSD) to report suspected occurrences of fraud, waste, and abuse without fear of retaliation. Also adopted were the accompanying Operations Manual and Investigation Guidelines used to implement the Policy.
