What is Manganese?



Natural mineral that enters the Potomac River via runoff

Not a health hazard

Manganese can cause discoloration of water even at very small levels

CURRENT WSSC LEVEL = 0.01 mg/L - 0.02 mg/L

Part of U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Secondary Drinking Water Regulations for aesthetic reasons only

EPA Secondary
Limit = 0.05 mg/L
