

Vine Street Water Main Replacement Project No. BR6249A17

As part of our ongoing efforts to enhance service and reliability to our customers, a WSSC Water project is coming to your neighborhood. It's all part of our commitment to strategically replace and rehabilitate the aging water and sewer mains throughout our service area.

As we get closer to construction, we plan to hold a community meeting to provide you and your neighbors with more details. In the meantime, please read this letter as it contains important information about this upcoming project.

Scope of Work

- Approximately 3.1 miles of cast iron water mains will be replaced under this project. In addition, the existing water service connections to homes will be replaced up to the property line located at the edge of the public right-of-way.
 - The affected streets include: Quinn Street, Urn Street, Nova Avenue, Vine Street, Dewitt Avenue, Cirus Place, Clark Place, Clark Street, Byers Street, Ellis Street, Arcadia Avenue, and Belt Road.
 - WSSC Water will be replacing/rehabilitating 3.1 miles of water mains with new zinc-coated ductile iron pipe, which is expected to last at least 100 years.
- The current water mains were installed 55 years ago and are nearing the end of their life cycle.
- WSSC Water will replace the portion of the water service line between our water main and the property line connection.

Estimated Project Schedule

- Estimated design completion: Spring 2018
- Estimated construction start: Fall 2020
- Estimated construction duration: More than 2 year include restoration time
- The estimated project schedule may change based on issuance of permits, available funds or inclement weather.


Additional Information

- Some trees may have to be pruned or removed to accommodate the work. If any trees need to be removed, residents will be notified prior to construction. All tree removal and pruning will be supervised by a WSSC Water urban forester.
- Your water service may be interrupted for a few hours while the new main is being connected. Residents will receive a 48-hour advance notification for planned service interruptions.
- WSSC Water will provide residents at least 48-hour advance notification in the event of any parking restrictions and changes in work hours.
- WSSC Water will restore sidewalks, roadways and landscaping within 90 days of construction completion.
- Projects completed during the winter months will be restored the following spring.
