

Quince Orchard Valley Neighborhood Park Sewer Rehabilitation Project Information Sheet

What is the Scope of Work?

The scope of work to be performed at this site consists of the rehabilitation of a 47 year-old, 1,509 Linear Feet (0.29 miles) sewer pipeline and repairing five (5) manholes. The sewer rehabilitation process includes Cured-In-Place-Pipe (CIPP) lining, which consists of trenchless technology requiring little to no digging or open trenches. It reinforces the interior of the pipe by lining and coating the existing walls, resulting in a pipe that will last another 50 to 100 years. Manhole rehabilitation methods include repairs to the inside of the manhole, or at the surface such as resetting or replacing the frame and cover with grade rings in order to bring a buried manhole to grade.

When will construction start on this project?

➤ A 14 day notice will be provided in advance of the start of construction.
