THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE #017M TO MANHOLE #018U, A TOTAL OF 247 FEET, HITTING AND RELIEVING A HEAVY ROOT BLOCKAGE AT 245 FEET, ENDING THE OVERFLOW.

IMPACTS UPON PUBLIC HEALTH AND STATE WATERS: DISCOLORATION DRY WEATHER NOTICEABLE ODOR VISIBLE SOLIDS, STREAM BANK

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE: THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW. A FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONDUC-TED TO DETERMINE WHAT MEASURES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN.

MEASURES INITIATED/TAKEN TO MINIMIZE IMPACT: LIME RAKED AREA VISIBLE SOLIDS REMOVED

The crew removed 75 pounds of roots from the bench, wall and channel of manhole #018u.
