THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE
ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW. A FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONDUCTED TO DETERMINE WHAT MEASURES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE
THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN.

THE SEWER MAIN WILL REMAIN ON OVERPUMPING UNTIL REPAIRS ARE COMPLETE. A CCTV INSPECTION WILL BE PERFORMED AFTER REPAIRS ARE COMPLETE.
