CAUSE: DEFECTIVE MATERIAL EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: UPON THE CREW'S ARRIVAL, THE PRESSURE SEWER SERVICE HAD A PINHOLE LEAK ON THE 1 1/4" PIPE, AND WAS LEAKING INTO THE GRASS. THE CREW SHUT OFF THE VALVE AND CHECK VALVE, ENDING THE OVERFLOW. THE CREW REPAIRED THE SERVICE WITH 2 FEET OF 1 1/4" PVC PIPE AND 2 COUPLINGS.

IMPACTS UPON PUBLIC HEALTH AND STATE WATERS:

NOTICEABLE ODOR PUBLIC ACCESS WET WEATHER

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE: THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW. A FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONDUC-TED TO DETERMINE WHAT MEASURES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN.

THIS OVERFLOW OCCURRED ON A PRESSURE SEWER SERVICE AND IS THEREFORE NOT CCTVABLE.
