WEATHER EVENT. THE PISCATAWAY RAW SEWAGE PUMPING STATION HAD EXCEEDED ITS CAPACITY, CAUSING THE COLLECTION SYSTEM TO SURCHARGE. THE COMBINED TOTAL ESTIMATED OVERFLOW WAS 123,385 GALLONS. ONCE THE EXCESS FLOW SUBSIDED, THE EVENT ENDED.

IMPACTS UPON PUBLIC HEALTH AND STATE WATERS: WET WEATHER

> SEWAGE ENTERED PISCATAWAY CREEK IN THE PISCATAWAY CREEK BASIN. MINIMAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT IS EXPECTED DUE TO THE EXTREME DILUTION EFFECT OF STORMWATER.

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE: THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW. A FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONDUC-TED TO DETERMINE WHAT MEASURES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN. ***** THE MANHOLES ARE LOCATED IN A SWAMPY, INACCESSIBLE AREA; THEREFORE, THESE LINES ARE NOT CCTVABLE.

MEASURES INITIATED/TAKEN TO MINIMIZE IMPACT: ON 12/18/18, A CREW RETURNED TO THE AREA AND CLEANED UP TISSUE AROUND RIM OF MANHOLE 002M. THE CREW ALSO REPLACED THE BOLTS ON MANHOLE 002M.
