CAUSE: GREASE EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: UPON ARRIVAL, THE INSPECTOR FOUND MANHOLE #082M OVERFLOWING 1 GALLON EVERY 5 MINUTES, ENTERING A STORM DRAIN IN THE PISCATAWAY CREEK BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE #081M TO MANHOLE #082M A TOTAL OF 95 FEET, HITTING AND RELIEVING GREASE AT 80 FEET, ENDING THE OVERFLOW.

IMPACTS UPON PUBLIC HEALTH AND STATE WATERS:

NOTICEABLE ODOR PUBLIC ACCESS DRY WEATHER

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE: THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW.
