CAUSE: EXCESS FLOW EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 74,000 GAL DURING A PERIOD OF HEAVY RAINFALL, EXCESS FLOWS TO THE BROAD CREEK WWPS EXCEEDED THE CAPACITY OF THE STATION, CAUSING AN OVERFLOW INTO A DRAINAGE DITCH THAT LEADS TO BROAD CREEK. THE OVERFLOW ENDED WHEN EXCESS FLOW SUBSIDED.

IMPACTS UPON PUBLIC HEALTH AND STATE WATERS:
PUBLIC ACCESS WET WEATHER

THE IMPACT TO THE RECEIVING STREAM SHOULD BE RELATIVELY LOW SINCE THE FLOW WAS DILUTED DUE TO THE RAIN.

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE: THE OVERFLOW OCCURRED AT THE BROAD CREEK WWPS, AND IS THEREFORE NOT CCTVABLE.

MEASURES INITIATED/TAKEN TO MINIMIZE IMPACT: LIME

VISIBLE DEBRIS WAS CLEANED UP AND HYDRATED LIME WAS APPLIED TO THE GRASSY AREAS ALONG THE SIDES OF THE DRAINAGE DITCH.
