UPON ARRIVAL, THE INSPECTOR FOUND MANHOLES #12015090N AND #12015191M EACH OVERFLOWING APPROXIMATELY TWO GALLONS PER MINUTE IN THE STREET, ENTERING A NEARBY STORM DRAIN IN THE LITTLE FALLS BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE #190M TO #090N, A TOTAL OF 273 FEET, HITTING AND RELIEVING HEAVY ROOTS AND GREASE AT 180 FEET; ENDING THE OVERFLOW.
