CAUSE: EXCESS FLOW EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 821,304 GAL HEAVY RAINS IN THE REGION CAUSED HIGH FLOWS TO ENTER THE BROAD CREEK WWPS DUE TO INFLOW/INFILTRATION INTO THE COLLECTION SYSTEM. THE STATION WAS RUNNING AT SAFE CAPACITY (5 OF 6 PUMPS), WITH 1 PUMP OUT OF SERVICE FOR MECHANICAL REPAIR. WET WELL LEVELS CONTINUTED TO RISE CAUSING THE STATION TO OVERFLOW. THE OVERFLOW ENDED WHEN EXCESS FLOW SUBSIDED.

IMPACTS UPON PUBLIC HEALTH AND STATE WATERS:

PUBLIC ACCESS WET WEATHER

REDUCED IMPACT TO BROAD CREEK IS EXPECTED DUE TO HIGH STREAM FLOW FROM THE STORM EVENT, AND THE DISCHARGED FLOW WAS DILUTED WITH STORM WATER FROM THE RAINS THAT ENTERED THE COLLECTION SYSTEM.

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE: THIS EVENT OCCURRED AT BROAD CREEK WWPS, AND IS THEREFORE NOT CCTVABLE.

MEASURES INITIATED/TAKEN TO MINIMIZE IMPACT:

LIME VISIBLE SOLIDS REMOVED

VISIBLE DEBRIS REMOVED AND LIME APPLIED UPON DAYLIGHT ON 10/12/18. THE OVERFLOW ENTERED A DRAINAGE DITCH THAT LEADS TO BROAD CREEK.
