UPON ARRIVAL, THE INSPECTOR DISCOVERED MANHOLE #033U OVERFLOWING INTO A WOODED AREA AT A RATE OF 5 GALLONS PER MINUTE. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE #033U TO #004U, A TOTAL OF 375 FEET, HITTING AND RELIEVING A HARD ROOT AND RAG OBSTRUCTION AT 1 FOOT; ENDING THE EVENT.

IMPACTS UPON PUBLIC HEALTH AND STATE WATERS: DISCOLORATION DRY WEATHER

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE: THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW. A FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONDUC-TED TO DETERMINE WHAT MEASURES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN.
