UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 221N OVERFLOWING APPROXIMATELY 1 GALLON PER MINUTE INTO A NEARBY STORM DRAIN, IN THE SENECA CREEK BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 211U TO 218U, A TOTAL OF 98 FEET, AND REMOVED A ROPE, WIPES, AND GREASE AT THE MOUTH OF MANHOLE 218U; ENDING THE OVERFLOW.
