UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 017M OVERFLOWING APPROXIMATELY 7 GPM, INTO A NEARBY CREEK IN THE NORTHWEST BRANCH BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 015M TO 016M, A TOTAL OF 137', AND RELIEVED A HEAVY WIPES AND GREASE OBSTRUCTION AT 120FT; ENDING THE EVENT.
