ACTION REQUESTED:

Purpose of Commission Package: To request approval to award Contract No. 16520 for the Strategy and Innovation Office (SIO) Support Services Basic Ordering Agreement (BOA) to Arcadis-US, Inc., Hazen and Sawyer, P.C., and Johnson, Mirmiran & Thompson, Inc., for a three (3) year Base Term with a Not to Exceed (NTE) amount of \$1,200,000.00 and two, one-year Option Terms with a combined NTE amount of \$800,000.00. The total Contract amount to be approved is \$2,000,000.00.

Basis of Award: This solicitation is being awarded to the firms deemed as the most advantageous to WSSC Water, taking into consideration the evaluation factors set forth in the Request for Proposals.

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

Contract No. 16520 will provide support services in digital strategy, strategic analytics, and innovation and research. Tasks issued under this contract may include, but are not limited to, the following: development of strategic and business plans, digital strategy, evaluation of new technology, new product evaluation, benchmarking, business cases for new products or technology, innovation office organization and effectiveness, data analytics, and dashboard development.

Task orders will be individually competed and awarded to the firm deemed most advantageous to WSSC Water.

The Office of Supplier Diversity & Inclusion ("OSDI") has reviewed the request for Award of Contract No. 16520 SIO Support Services BOA. In accordance with MBE Program Regulation (WSSC Water Code of Regulations Chapter 6.30) and SLBE Program Regulation (WSSC Water Code of Regulations Chapter 6.35), this solicitation was advertised with a 20.00% Minority Business Enterprise and Small Local Business Enterprise (MBE/SLBE) subcontracting requirement that can only be satisfied by WSSC Water-Approved SLBEs (SLBE only or SLBE-SDVs) and the following qualified and certified-MBE firms: African American, Asian American, Native American and Female/Women-Owned.

This Solicitation was advertised in WSSC Water's Supplier Portal System and through the Commission's normal procurement process. An Evaluation Committee was established with defined evaluation criteria. One thousand ninety-eight (1,098) firms were notified, three hundred fifty-nine (359) firms downloaded the solicitation and twenty (20) proposals were received. One proposal was deemed non-responsive by the Procurement Office.

Arcadis-US, Inc., a majority-owned firm located in Laurel, Maryland, Johnson Mirmiran & Thompson, Inc., a majority-owned firm located in Hunt Valley, Maryland and Hazen and Sawyer, a majority-owned firm located in Baltimore, Maryland are the recommended awardees by the Procurement Office. The contract has a base term of three years with two (2) one-year option terms. The contract value for the base term is \$1,200,000.00.
