5GPM INTO A NEARBY CREEK; IN THE LITTLE FALLS BASIN. THE CREW JETTED
FROM MANHOLE 135U THRU 134M TO 025U A TOTAL OF 418FT, AND RELIEVED A
HEAVY GREASE BLOCKAGE AT 418FT; ENDING THE EVENT.
