CAUSE: GREASE AND WIPES EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 4,378 GAL UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 219M OVERFLOWING APPROXIMATELY 12GPM INTO THE ANACOSTIA RIVER, LOCATED IN THE NORTHEAST BRANCH BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 045U THROUGH 215M, TO 216M, A TOTAL OF 245FT, RELIEVING A GREASE AND WIPES OBSTRUCTION AT

245FT TO END THE EVENT.
