CAUSE: DEBRIS EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 20,916 GAL DAMAGE TO THE STORAGE FACILITY DRAIN LINE DURING CONTRACTOR EXCAVATION ACTIVITY NEAR THE RAW STATION AT THE PISCATAWAY WRRF ALLOWED FOR GROUND WATER TO ENTER THE DRAIN LINE, ALONG WITH APPROXIMATELY 15 CUBIC YARDS OF STONE. THIS RESTRICTED INFLUENT FLOW AND WHEN THE FLOW INCREASED IN THE MORNING, IT CAUSED THE MANHOLE OUTSIDE THE FENCE TO OVERFLOW. THE CONTRACTOR SET UP BYPASS PIPING TO END THE EVENT.

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE: DUE TO THE FLOWS IN THE INFLUENT GRAVITY SEWER, THE SEGMENT IS NOT CCTVABLE. WHILE THE LINE WAS ON BYPASS, THE CONTRACTOR REMOVED THE STONE OBSTRUCTIONS, REPAIRED THE BROKEN PIPE, AND PROCEEDED WITH THEIR WORK ON FACILITY UPGRADES.
