UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 138M OVERFLOWING APPROXIMATELY
1 GALLON PER MINUTE INTO A NEARBY CREEK, IN THE PATUXENT CENTER
BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 136U TO 138M A TOTAL OF 125 FEET,
AND RELIEVED A HEAVY GREASE OBSTRUCTION TO END THE EVENT.
