UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 050N OVERFLOWING AT APPROXIMATELY 2 GALLONS PER MINUTE INTO A NEARBY CREEK, IN THE NORTHEAST BRANCH BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 049M TO 050N, A TOTAL OF 230FT, AND RELIEVED WIPES AT 165FT TO END THE EVENT.
