UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 013M OVERFLOWING APPROXIMATELY 3GPM GOING INTO A NEARBY STORM DRAIN THAT ENTERS PARKWAY BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 029M-009U-010M TOTAL 823FT AND WERE UNABLE TO RELIEVE A HARD UNKNOWN BLOCKAGE. CONTRACTORS SET UP OVER PUMPING TO END THE EVENT

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE:

THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW. A FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONDUCTED TO DETERMINE WHAT MEASURES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN. THE SEGMENT IS ON BYPASS, AND THEREFORE CANNOT YET BE CCTV INSPECTED. THE REPORT WILL BE UPDATED UPON COMPLETION OF REPAIRS AND CCTV INSPECTION.
