CAUSE: DEFECTIVE MATERIAL EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 289 GAL UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 008M OVERFLOWING AT 1GPM, GOING INTO A STORM DRAIN THAT ENTERS THE NORTHEAST BRANCH BASIN. A COLLAPSED DROP CONNECTION IN MANHOLE 007M CAUSED THE OVERFLOW. A WSSC CONTRACTOR SET UP A BYPASS AND BEGAN OVER-PUMPING OPERATIONS, ENDING THE EVENT.

THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN.
