CAUSE: ROOTS & GREASE EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 181 GAL UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 012M OVERFLOWING APPROXIMATELY 1 GPM INTO THE GRASSY AREA AROUND THE MANHOLE. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 011M TO MANHOLE 012M, A TOTAL OF 400', AND HIT AND RELIEVED GREASE AND ROOTS AT 170', TO END THE EVENT.

IMPACTS UPON PUBLIC HEALTH AND STATE WATERS: DRY WEATHER NOTICEABLE ODOR

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE: THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW. A FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONDUC-TED TO DETERMINE WHAT MEASURES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN.
