UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 058M OVERFLOWING AT 1 GPM ONTO THE PAVEMENT AND INTO A STORM DRAIN THAT OUTFALLS INTO SLIGO CREEK. MANHOLE 057M WAS ALSO FOUND HOLDING SEWAGE. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 055U TO 057M, A TOTAL OF 208', AND HIT AND RELIEVED A DEBRIS BLOCKAGE AT 147', TO END THE EVENT.
