CAUSE: GREASE AND WIPES EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 983 GAL UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 119M OVERFLOWING AT APPROXIMATELY 6 GPM. THE CREW THEN JETTED FROM MANHOLE 118U TO MANHOLE 119M, A TOTAL OF 121', AND HIT AND RELIEVED WIPES AND GREASE AT 119', TO END THE EVENT.
