CAUSE: GREASE AND WIPES EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 265 GAL UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 065M OVERFLOWING AT 1GPM, ONTO THE GRASSY AREA AROUND THE MANHOLE, AND INTO A NEARBY CREEK THAT OUTFALLS INTO THE SENECA CREEK BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 066U TO MANHOLE 156U, AND HIT AND REMOVED A GREASE AND WIPES BLOCKAGE 210' DOWNSTREAM OF MANHOLE 065M, TO END THE EVENT.

IMPACTS UPON PUBLIC HEALTH AND STATE WATERS:

DISCOLORATION DRY WEATHER

NOTICEABLE ODOR VISIBLE SOLIDS, IN STREAM
