CAUSE: UNKNOWN EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 50 GAL
UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND EVIDENCE OF AN OVERFLOW OF
APPROXIMATELY 50 GALLONS AROUND THE PROPERTY LINE CLEANOUT, AND INTO
A NEARBY STORM DRAIN THAT OUTFALLS INTO PAINT BRANCH. A WSSC
PLUMBER SNAKE FROM THE PROPERTY LINE CLEANOUT A TOTAL OF 45', AND
RELIEVED AN UNKNOWN BLOCKAGE AT 20', TO END THE EVENT.

STEPS TAKEN OR PLANNED TO REDUCE, ELIMINATE AND PREVENT RECURRENCE:
THE PROBLEM WITH THIS SEWER LINE HAS BEEN REFERRED TO LINE BLOCKAGE
ANALYSIS (LBA) FOR REVIEW. A FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION WILL BE
CONDUCTED TO DETERMINE WHAT MEASURES SHOULD BE TAKEN TO REDUCE OR
ELIMINATE THE CHANCE OF THIS LINE OVERFLOWING AGAIN.

RAKED AREA VISIBLE SOLIDS REMOVED

A WSSC CREW RAKED THE AREA, AND WASHED DOWN THE AREA AROUND THE
CLEANOUT.
