UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND A LEAK ON A VALVE FOR A PRESSURE SEWER AT THE CUSTOMERS PROPERTY LINE. A VOLUME OF 1 GPM ENTERED A STORM DRAIN THAT OUTFALLS INTO SENECA CREEK. THE PROPERTY IS NEWLY CONSTRUCTED AND IS STILL UNDER WARRENTY FROM THE BUILDER. THE BUILDERS CONTRACTOR REPAIRED THE LEAK, TO END THE EVENT.
