UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 095M OVERFLOWING APPROXIMATELY 3GPM, ONTO THE GRASSY AREA AROUND THE MANHOLE AND INTO A NEARBY WATERWAY THAT OUTFALLS INTO ROCK CREEK. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 0954U TO 095M A TOTAL OF 80FT, AND HIT AND RELIEVED ROOTS AT 75FT, TO END THE EVENT.
