Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission Calendar Year 2011 Annual Ethics Report

This report covers conflicts of interest and lobbyist registration and reporting matters that were addressed by the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC) Board of Ethics during calendar year 2011.

The current WSSC Board of Ethics members are Steven J. Hausman (Montgomery County), Robert J. Moore (Prince George's County), George E. Pruden, II, (Prince George's County), and Rachel B. Brown, Alternate Member, (Montgomery County). The Board of Ethics convened twelve times during 2011 to consider and review requests for advisory opinions, complaints, and other matters. During the year, the Board of Ethics issued two (2) Advisory Opinions on conflicts of interest topics and two (2) decisions regarding Complaints. Attached is a summary of each Advisory Opinion and Complaint (Appendix A).

The Board of Ethics web site http://www.wsscwater.com/home/jsp/content/ethics-index.faces contains the WSSC Code of Ethics, Lobbyist registration information, Advisory Opinions and Waivers issued as well as the Board of Ethics Rules and Procedures.

The WSSC Code of Ethics requires an individual to register as a lobbyist if s/he is compensated to influence executive or administrative actions by the WSSC. Attached is a summary of the Lobbyist Expenditures as reported on the WSSC Lobbyist Activity Report (Appendix B).

The WSSC Code of Ethics also requires certain employees to file annual financial disclosure forms. State law requires that the content of WSSC's financial disclosure regulations be "substantially similar" to the State.

Finally, we would like to highlight a few activities that have occurred during CY 2011.

- Workforce completed annual Conflict of Interest Statements during the month of April 2011.
- Ethics Officer provided face-to-face ethics training from April 6, 2011 to June 28, 2011 to over 1,450 WSSC employees at various locations.
- On November 16, 2011, ethics training was provided to the WSSC Commissioners.
- On October 27, 2011, the Ethics Officer sent informational letters to potential
 Lobbyists as Phase I of the new WSSC Lobbyist Awareness and Registration
 Campaign. The information provided to the potential Lobbyists included, but was not
 limited to, the registration fees and activity reports required when registering. We
 also provided information to potential Lobbyists that were in attendance at a Small,
 Local Minority Business Enterprise (SLMBE) Office outreach event held during the
 year.
