

Dear Takoma Park Resident:

In response to requests from residents and elected officials, WSSC is moving forward with a full environmental assessment and construction impact study for the final three sewer alignment alternatives in the 6700 block of Eastern Avenue. We will not be holding an alignment vote after Monday's public workshop. Instead, we will hold the vote after Montgomery County's Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) completes a review of the impact study.

WSSC will still hold Monday's public workshop as a project update and informational session about the three remaining sewer alignments in the 6700 block. I will present an updated project timeline in consideration of the study completion and review by DEP. In addition, I will discuss moving forward immediately with the final design and contractor procurement processes for sections of the project where this is feasible; and I will present an updated timeline for these project sections as well. Following the workshop, WSSC will offer one-on-one meetings with homeowners in the 6700 block of Eastern Avenue to review the impacts of the three remaining sewer alignments at individual properties.

Thank you for your patience as we move forward to the completion of this project. I look forward to speaking with you further about the project status and next steps on Monday. Thank you and have a good weekend.
